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Absence Notification

The notification is a legal requirement upon both the school and parents. This notification must be received within a 7 day period or the absence will be marked as unjustified. All absences are monitored remotely by the Department of Education Home School Liaison Officer.

Healthy Lunch Ideas from the Cancer Council

SAVOURY ZUCCHINI MUFFINS

Ingredients

2 zucchinis, grated & liquid squeezed out
 1 carrot, grated
 125g tin corn kernels, drained
 1 small red onion, finely diced
 1 cup baby spinach leaves, chopped
 1 cup wholemeal self-raising flour
 6 eggs, beaten
 1 cup reduced-fat tasty cheese, grated

Method

Preheat oven to 180oC. Line a 12-hole muffin tin with muffin liners.
 Heat a non-stick frypan over medium heat and cook the onion until translucent. Allow to cool.
 Place all ingredients into a large mixing bowl and mix until well combined.
 Divide the mixture between the 12 muffin liners. Bake for 25 to 30 minutes or until muffins are golden and a skewer comes out clean.

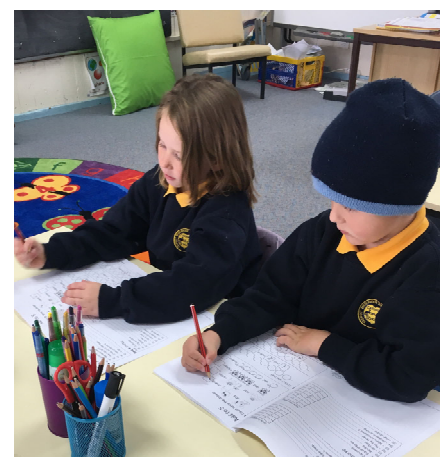
