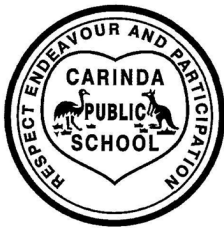



2021 WALGETT SHOW SOCIETY JUNIOR JUDGING COMPETITION

The final event on the Walgett Show Society calendar for the 2021 Show year is Junior Judging, which will be held on Sunday July 4th at Walgett Showground. Come along for a fun and educational day out! Morning Tea and Lunch will be available.

Judging will start at 9.00 AM, with Merino Fleeces, Merino Sheep, Meat Sheep and Beef Cattle judging, as well as Poultry and the popular sheep counting - men, ladies, girls and boys.

The Senior section is for judges 14-24 years (with the possibility for winners to participate in ASC Judging Group and State finals - see Walgett Show Schedule or ASC website www.agshowsnsw.org.au for details).

There is also a section for Junior judges under 14 years, and depending on numbers, there may be a further Sub-junior section.

The overall senior Champion Judge will be awarded the E.P. Colless Memorial prize of a \$250 open order to be spent at any local rural agency. Thank you to the family of the late Mr Edward P Colless for generously donating the Champion Judge prize, which honours a long-time supporter of Walgett Show Society and Junior Judging. For the U14 years judges, there are two special prizes of \$25 local vouchers. There are also ribbons for judging and the sheep counting place-getters.
